Dear Community Organizations/Local Businesses:

The Parent-Teacher-Counselor-Organization (PTCO) of the Indiana School for the Deaf (ISD) is proud to confirm the date of its annual traditional event, the **PTCO Day Festival!** This will take place on **Sunday, May 3, 2009** from 11:00am to 5:00pm. The PTCO Day Festival draws over 1,500 attendees annually, and will once again be held on the grounds of ISD, near Caskey Gym.

One of the event's most important features has always been the **Community Booth** area. We are pleased to announce that PTCO Day 2009 will once again highlight this feature. This creates a great opportunity for agencies, clubs, community organizations, local businesses and individuals to develop networks and referrals, and share information on services, products and programs. There will also be booths selling food and other products.

We invite you to set up a booth at this, one of the largest Deaf community events in Indiana. An exhibitor application form is enclosed, for return by the deadline of **WEDNESDAY APRIL 22, 2009. PLEASE** ensure you read the application in full – it is vital that you understand your responsibilities as an exhibitor, and the expectations that come with setting up and manning your booth. Make sure you keep a copy for your own records.

IMPORTANT NOTES:

- ☞ In addition to the booth fee, which is non-refundable, there is a **'clean-up' deposit** of \$10.00. This deposit will be refunded to you if you:
 - Leave your booth area in a clean and neat condition.
 - Return tables and chairs to their appropriate places.
 - Remove any trash or leftover goods from your booth area.
 - We will have workers monitoring cleanup – if you do not clean up to their satisfaction, you will forfeit the \$10.00 deposit.

- ☞ An additional charge of \$5.00 will be added for any booth that requires **electricity**. We will provide the generators, but you are responsible to bring your own electrical cords.
- ☞ If you require **Internet** access, contact Peter Pickering, Network Administrator, ppickering@isd.k12.in.us, to organize this. Please note that there may be an additional charge for Internet – PTCO has no control over this.
- ☞ If you plan to sell raffle tickets or carry out other gaming activities, you **MUST** have a **gaming license**. **PTCO's license DOES NOT cover any activities other than PTCO's own activities**. You can find out more about a license by visiting www.in.gov/igc, then click on "Charity Gaming" under IGC Divisions in the column on the left. **** Once again, you are responsible to organize this yourself – PTCO takes no responsibility for any issues that may arise from gaming activities conducted without a proper license. ****
